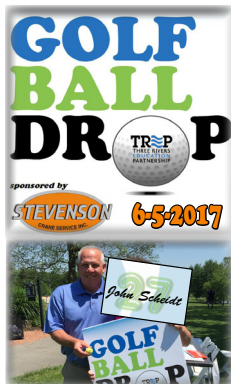


New Golf Ball Drop Event a Great Success
