Dear Valued Contractor:

Three Rivers Manufacturers' Association (TRMA) established an awards program to recognize the safety performance of contractor companies working at member company sites. We would like to thank everyone who has participated in our awards programs in the past and invite you to submit your application for the 2014 Safety Awards. These awards will be presented at the 2015 Annual TRMA Dinner meeting. The award's criterion has changed from past years and we ask you review it careful as the requirements to qualify for awards have been tightened to reflect the ever increasing expectations from the owners.

Contractor Company Awards: Contractor companies are eligible if **10 or more** of their employees have attended the Contractor Safety Orientation training at the Three Rivers Safety Center and have worked a combined total of **at least 2,000 hours** in 2014 at TRMA member sites. Awards will be based on work performed at TRMA facilities **AND** the contractor company performance.

Award for Meritorious Performance for High Risk Work: Applicants must achieve a total OSHA recordable incidence rate of 0.6 or less while working at TRMA facilities, achieve an overall company recordable incidence rate of 2.0 or less, and have no work-related fatalities during calendar year 2014. Only contractor companies performing work judged as high risk (fabrication, installation, construction, etc.) are eligible for this award.

Award for Meritorious Performance for Low Risk Work: Applicants must have worked without experiencing an OSHA recordable injury during the calendar year 2014 at TRMA facilities and achieve an overall company recordable incidence rate of 2.0 or less. Only contractor companies performing work judged as low risk (such as engineering, design, administration, testing, inspection, etc.) are eligible for this award.

Gold Award: Applicants must achieve a 25% or greater reduction in the total OSHA recordable incidence rate with no workplace related fatalities during calendar year 2014 as compared to the average of the total recordable incidence rates for the three previous calendar years. The 25% reduction must have been achieved for work done at TRMA plants AND the overall company recordable incidence rate. Applicants that experienced no OSHA recordable in the previous 3 years (2012-2014) will also be eligible.

Platinum Award: In order to qualify for this Award, a Contractor must conduct high risk work, have a threeyear average OSHA recordable rate of 0.6 or less, a three-year Lost Workday rate of 0.2 or less, no fatalities during that same time period, have an OSHA recordable rate of 0 in 2014 for work done at TRMA facilities and have worked a minimum of 250,000 hours at TRMA facilities in aggregate in the past 3 years. After passing these screening criteria, the applicant would need to be nominated by the TRMA plants where the applicant worked in 2014. TRMA will contact the plants to discuss the nominations.

Companies wanting to be considered for these awards need to submit the completed application with copies of Form 300A for 2011 through 2014 **no later than February 13, 2015.** Contact Jerry Caamano at 815-774-6070 if you have any questions about the Awards application.
