

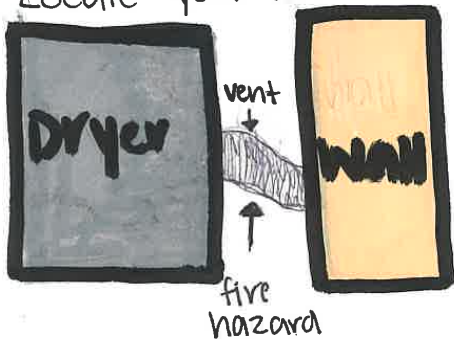


# How to Avoid Dryer Fires

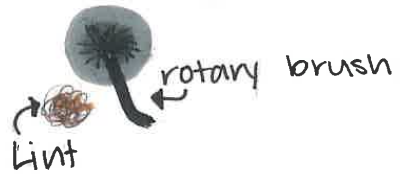
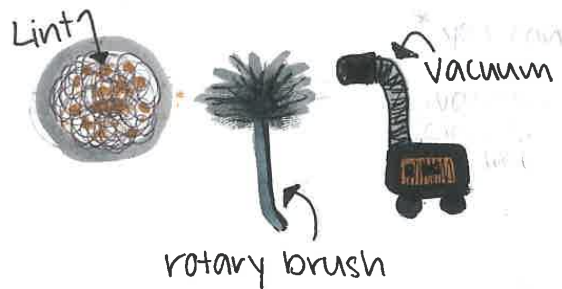
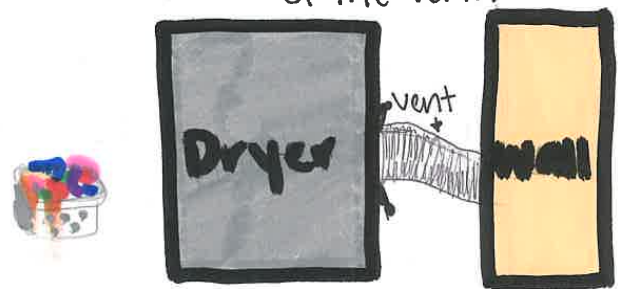


Between 2,900 and 16,000 dryer fires are documented every year in the U.S. Don't add to that!

1. Locate your vent.



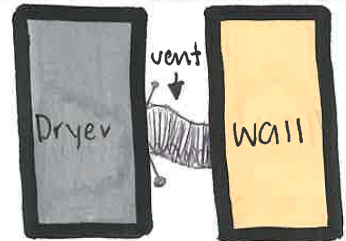
2. Carefully detach one side of the vent.



3. Find a rotary cleaning brush or vacuum with a long attachment.

4. Use either one to clean out the lint, careful to not push it in further.

Clean vent



5. Make sure the vent is completely clean.

6. Reattach the vent. Repeat 2-3x per year!

Congratulations! You just avoided one of the leading causes of house fires in the U.S!
