

ATSSA Flagger Certification

The American Traffic Safety Services Association (ATSSA) is a recognized certification by the Illinois Department of Transportation. This 4-hour course is designed to satisfy Federal, State and Local flagger certification requirements for persons performing the duties of a flagger according to the most recent edition of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).

Topics include proper flagger equipment, when and where to apply flagger applications, and how to safely and effectively perform ATSSA flagger signals and duties. ATSSA is a recognized certification by the Department of Transportation and the course content follows the most recent Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). This course satisfies Federal, State (Illinois) and Local flagger certification requirements.

By the end of this course, participants will be able to:

- Recognize flagger work zone hazards
- Identify proper flagger equipment
- Perform National ATSSA Flagger hand signals
- Perform National ATSSA Flagging signals
